



## Multi-modal Transportation Infrastructure

- Four-lane US Hwy. 72, runs east-west through Jackson County, with Memphis serving as its western terminus and I-24 just west of Chattanooga as its eastern terminus. Other major interstates serving Jackson County include I-565, I-59, I-65, and I-75.
- Mainline rail service in Jackson County is provided by CSX and Norfolk Southern. Short line rail service is provided by Sequatchie Valley Railroad.
- The Alabama State Port Authority has licensed inland port in Bridgeport allowing barge shipments to the Port of Mobile.

- Jackson County is within a half-day's drive to many major metropolitan areas in the southern and central United States.
- Scottsboro is located 45 minutes from Huntsville, one hour from Chattanooga, approximately two hours from Birmingham and Nashville, and three hours from Atlanta.
